The Lunch Drawings

Taking inspiration from the likes of John Fischetti, Pat Oliphant, and Bill Mauldin, Fitzpatrick grounds his contemporary fine collage work in Chicago culture, his blue collar roots, and a decades-old conviction for change. Drawing heavily on history and an intense, longterm relationship with comics, magazines and political cartoons, **Tony Fitzpatrick: The Lunch Drawings** invites you back to your childhood--and to freedom.

"When I was a young man I read a collection of poems by Frank O'hara entitled *Lunch Poems*. He wrote them on his lunch break while working at the Museum of Modern Art selling memberships. Every lunch he would go out, and he could go anywhere in the world in his poetry.

I began these over 10 years ago, the first ones simple and small -- completed in a couple hours. Now they take a little longer than that, but we never start them before noon. They may not end at Lunch but they always start at Lunch. It's also a return to making work in the way that I made work as a kid. Just doing whatever the fuck I wanted to. They're drawings that can't be captured or planned, these are the drawings where I'm free."

TONY FITZPATRICK (b.1963) is a Chicago-based artist best known for his multimedia collages, printmaking, paintings, and drawings. Fitzpatrick's work are inspired by Chicago street culture, cities he has traveled to, children's books, tattoo designs, and folk art. Fitzpatrick has authored or illustrated eight books of art and poetry, and, for the last two years has written a column for the Newcity. Fitzpatrick's art appears in the Museum of Modern Art in New York City, the Met, the Museum of Contemporary Art in Chicago, and the National Museum of American Art in Washington, DC. The Neville Brothers' album Yellow Moon and the Steve Earle's albums El Corazon and The Revolution Starts Now also feature Fitzpatrick's art. In 1992, Fitzpatrick opened a Chicago-based printmaking studio, Big Cat Press. Before making a living as an artist, Fitzpatrick worked as a radio host, bartender, boxer, construction worker, and film and stage actor.




Churchy (Far from the Swamp)




Tennessee Tuxedo (In Chicago, Among the Wonder)




Stone Cold Jail-Dog (Among the Known Associates)




Hannah Chavez

B. 1990 Oregon, USA

Hannah Chavez is a Chicago based artist who captures the world around her in ink drawings. She works as if writing in a diary, recounting spaces, people and objects that speak to her state of being. As a student at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, Chavez focused primarily on drawing and printmaking.


Sierra Severson

B. 1990 California, USA

Sierra Severson is an analog collage artist from coastal California now based in Chicago. In a world of media saturation, Sierra finds it therapeutic to be able to manipulate and create something entirely new from the wealth of images that already exist. Analog collage began as a therapy practice, a respite from screens and technology, as well an appreciation for the preciousness of print media from the past. Her work is informed by her previous life as a social worker, and inspired by her ongoing love affair with music and film. She creates works involving architecture, nature, the human condition, and the ongoing struggle for women's sovereignty. She strives to inspire introspection and create surreal moments of joy and dark comedy while dealing with heavy subjects.

Owen Spryszak

B. **1997**, Detroit, USA

Owen Spryszak is a painter ffocusing on ink/oil paintings. His work explores both Western and Eastern art history through abstraction and figuration. In his ink paintings, Spryszak filters techniques, themes, and conventions of traditional Chinese Guohua ink painting with a contemporary surreal sensibility. Much of his work is concerned with themes of mutable-time and temporality. Spryszak positions image making as not only an exercise in technical skill and art historical knowledge, but also a reflection of lived experiences and his unconscious mind. You can find him walking his dog, eating bread, or in the studio watching the Pistons blow another season.

Messejah's work is centered around his ancestral journey from the American South, life in Chicago and his identity as a Black American living under colonialism. He works with the intent to archive personal memories through paintings, poetry, cinematography, and sculpture.
